



Water Supply and Drinking Water Quality Management Plans

Do you supply your own water on site? If so, there is a requirement to operate under a Department of Health approved Drinking Water Quality Management Plan (DWQMP).

The DWQMP sets out the monitoring requirements, frequency and reporting requirements to ensure that public health is maintained.

Compliance Monitoring can assist with the preparation of the DWQMP, sampling services in accordance with AS 5667 and 2031 and/or training of local staff.
